ALBERTINE	Cig. Wichuriana, 1921, coppery bud, informal shaped salmon pink, 6m, spring flowering
AMERICAN PILLAR	Cig. Wich. 1902, Carmine pink white centre, 6m, spring flowering.
ANNA OLIVIER	Tea, 1872, High centred double bloom, soft pink to buff apricot, fragrant, vigorous healthy bush.
ARCHDUKE CHARLES	China rose, 1830, Pale pink to deep pink, Compact bush, repeat flowering.
AUTUMN DELIGHT	Hybrid Musk, 1933, Compact bush, 1.5-2m clusters, almost single cream flowers.
BABY FARAUX	Polyantha, 1924, min. sized bush, Amethyst flowers fragrant.
BALLERINA	Hybrid musk, 1937, soft pink pale centre, repeats well, no fragrance.
BLUSH NOISETTE	Cig., 3m, 1815, Noisette pale pink, few thorns, repeats flowering, fragrance.
BOULE DE NEIGE	Bourbon rose, 1867, pure white, fragrance, 1.5m.
BUFF BEAUTY	Cig. hybrid musk, 1939, 3m, repeat flowering, fragrance, straw yellow to apricot flowers.
CATHERINE MERMET	Tea Rose, 1869, Beautiful shade of warm, light pink, good form and sweet fragrance.
CECILE BRUNNER	Cig., 1904, tiny well formed salmon pink bloom profusely on upright shrub recurrent.
CHAPEAU DE NAPOLEON	R.centifolia Cristata-Crested moss, warm pink globular flowers, spring flowering.
CLAIR MATIN	Shrub rose Meiland, soft salmon pink, continuous flowering.
CONSTANCE SPRY	Shrub rose, 1961, clear pink, 3m, strong fragrance, spring flowering.
COPPELIA	Shrub rose Kordes, free flowering rich pink, perpetual 2.5-3.0m.
CORNELIA	Hybrid Musk, 1925, raspberry pink flushed yellow small flowers, semi double and fragrant. Compact Shrub.
CREPUSCULE	Noisette, 1904, free blooming shrub/climber small orange apricot flowers, almost evergreen glossy foliage.
DAINTY BESS	Early H.T., 1925, Clusters of large silvery pink single flowers with strong scent, vigorous bush.
DESPREZ A FLEUR JAUNE	Noisette 1830, flat flowers pale yellow with peach fragrant, repeat flowering up to 5m.
DOROTHY PERKINS	Wichuriana Hybrid, 1902, rambler with cascades of rosy pink pompoms, spring flowering, 5m.
DUCHESS DE BRABANT	Tea Rose, 1857, Intensely fragrant, free flowering, long tulip like buds, delightful rose pink shade. Taller growth.
DUPONTII	Gallica, 1817, Climber with large single very pale pink flowers, fragrant, spring flowering, attractive rosehips.
ELMSHORN	Shrub rose/Climber, 1951, Clusters of red pompon type blooms, slightly fragrant, repeat flowering to 3m.
FANTIN LATOUR	Centifolia, ca 1900, full petalled, blush pink quartered, fragrant flowers in abundance.
F.J. GROOTENDORST	Rugosa Hybrid, 1918, Clusters of small rich crimson blooms on medium upright bush, recurrent flowering.
FELICIA	Hybrid Musk, 1928, buds coral to apricot opening to semi-double flowers with hint of peach, fragrant repeating.
FIMBRIATA	Rugosa Hybrid, 1891, palest pink open flowers, fragrant upright medium bush, the frilled flowers repeat well.
FRAU DAGMAR HASTRUP	Rugosa Hybrid, 1914, large single lilac-pink flowers with cream stamens on low bush, slight perfume, perpetual.
FRAU KARL DRUSCHKI	Hybrid perp. 1901 clear white double fragrant climber.
FRITZ NOBIS	Hybrid eleganteria, elegant shaped salmon pink blooms cover this matt green shrub in spring, to 2m height.
GENERAL JAQUEMINOT	Hybrid Perpetual, 1853, large ruffled red blooms very fragrant, recurrent on tall shrub to 2m.
GLOIRE DE DUCHER	Hybrid Perpetual, 1865, large cerise-red globular buds open to a rich magenta, fragrant, 2-5m.
GOLDEN OPHELIA	Tea Rose, sport of Ophelia, yellow to pale golden flowers, recurrent to 2m in height.
GOLDEN MOSS	Moss Rose, 1932, semi-double blooms of apricot-yellow, slightly recurrent, aromatic moss on young branches

VARIETY	
GOLDEN WINGS	Cig.shrub, light yellow single flowers deepening in the centre with orange stamens, recurrent, to 3m fragrant.
GRUSS AN ACHEN	Low shrub, 1909, hardy plant with soft pink flushed yellow blooms in abundance, fragrant.
HENRI MARTIN	Red Moss, 1863, medium spreading shrub with bright crimson blooms, semi-double in clusters in Spring.
HERITAGE BLEU	Shrub Rose of unknown origin, flowers are deep mauve to lavender frilly repeat flowering and heavily scented. Height to 2.5m.
ISPAHAN	Damask, fully double light pink with deeper centre in clusters richly scented, to 2m in spring.
JEAN DUCHER	Tea, early 1880's, hardy plant with abundance of scented peach pink to apricot flowers recurrent.
KATHLEEN HARROP	Bourbon Cig. 1919, thornless soft pink with slightly deeper tones on the reverse, repeat flowering very fragrant.
LADY HILLINGDON	Tea Rose, 1910, pointed buds, opening to superb golden yellow flowers, dark foliage.
LA REINE VICTORIA	Bourbon, 1872, soft rose pink blooms dainty with shell shaped petals, beautiful fragrance, recurrent.
LAMARQUE	Cig. Noisette, 1830, sprays of shapely buds opening to creamy-white flowers, yellow centres, frag., recurrent.
LEDA	Damask, buds of brick brown open to soft white with crimson margin, fragrant compact spring flowering.
LORRAINE LEE	Cig. Rose, 1924, flowers are loose rose pink in abundance on vigorous shrub, winter flowering if pruned in autumn, 5m.
LOUISE ODIER	Bourbon 1851, double rose pink flowers in clusters, very fragrant repeat flowering, healthy plant to 1.8m.
MME.ABEL CHATENAY	Tea, 1897, soft pink flowers with bronze foliage on tall bush, fragrant and repeats well.
MME.AFRED CARRIERE	Noisette, 1879, Free flowering white climber 4.5m, flowers cupped tinted pink, heavily scented.
MME DE WATTEVILLE	Tea Rose, 1883 - lemon yellow pink edges, sweetly fragrant, moderate sized bush
MME.ERNST CALVAT	Bourbon, 1888, Pillar or large shrub, flowers are flesh pink with deeper shadings, very fragrant recurrent.
MME.GREGOIRE STAEHELIN	Climber 1927, flowers very double clear pink to coral in clusters and single, rich fragrance in Spring.
MME.HARDY	Damask, 1832, soft sweet fragrant white with distinctly quartered petals, low spreading and spring flowering.
MME.ISAAC PEREIRE	Bourbon, 1881, flowers deep pink overlaid with magenta heavily scented, repeat flowering.
MME.LEGRAS DE ST. GERMAIN	Alba, 1846, large camelia like ivory white flowers open to cream in centre, almost thornless spring flowering.
MME.PIERRE OGER	Bourbon, 1878, pale rose pink blushing deeper in summer repeat flowering and very scented, 2.5m.
MRS B. CANT	Tea Rose, 1901 - large cupped blooms, bronze red colour, paler reverse. Long flowering.
MAIGOLD	Shrub Rose Kordes, open golden yellow flushed orange flowers suitable pillar rose, fragrant recurrent.
MAMON COCHET	Tea Rose, peach to coral pink flowers on healthy medium plant perpetual flowering, some scent.
MACARTNEY ROSE	R.Bracteata, vigorous climber with single white flowers and contrasting yellow stamens in Spring.
MAX GRAF	Rugosa x Wichuriana Hybrid, 1919, groundcover, single rose pink flowers over long period in Spring.
MERMAID	R.bracteata x, 1918, climber large flowered, palest yellow single flowers, softly scented, recurrent.
MONSIEUR TILLIER	Tea, 1891, abundant blooms of coral pink with magenta plump buds, fragrant, repeat flowering.
MOONSPRITE	Low shrub, compact with cool cream and pale gold colours of the rising moon, fragrant and repeat flowering.
MUTABILIS CHINENSIS	R.chinensis, 1932, tall china to 3m, flowers single opening yellow pastel to pink, carmine and crimson recurrent.
